Germizene™ is a ready-to-use spray **hospital - grade disinfectant** for disinfection of hard, non-porous, non-food contact surfaces. **Germizene** kills 99.99% of bacteria (*Pseudomonas aeruginosa* ATCC 15442, *Salmonella enterica* ATCC 10708, *Staphylococcus aureus* ATCC 6538, *Klebsiella pneumoniae* ATCC 4352) and viruses (H1N1 Influenza A virus, human coronavirus) after a 5 minute contact time at room temperature.

SECTION 3: DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all Directions for Use carefully before applying.

To disinfect hard, non-porous, non-food contact surfaces from bacteria and viruses for up to 48 hours on a disturbed surface:

To Disinfect:

Clean the surface to remove visible soil.

Pump Sprayer Application:

Using the pump sprayer, hold the bottle 6-8 inches away from hard non-porous surface(s) and apply Germizene as a coarse spray to completely wet the surface (normally 2 to 3 sprays), but not to liquid pooling or run-off. Do not wipe off for at least 5 minutes after application: then use sterile water or an alcohol-based wipe to wipe clean, or allow to air dry.

Electrostatic Sprayer Application:

Wear a full-face respirator or half-respirator with face shield with appropriate cannister, gloves, long pants, solid shoes, and long sleeves. Transfer Germizene from the bottle to the sprayer reservoir. Apply Germizene using an electrostatic sprayer to hard non-porous surface(s) to completely wet the surface. Do not wipe off for at least 5 minutes after application: then use sterile water or an alcohol-based wipe to wipe clean, or allow to air dry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food by storage and disposal.

Storage

Store in original container in a cool, dry area away from heat or flame, and inaccessible to children or domestic animals.

For all methods of application, wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, and chemical-resistant gloves (such as or made out of any waterproof material, selection Category A). Remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.
